The Council is satisfied that the principle that the meeting be conducted in a place open to the public has been outweighed in the circumstances because the release of the information could prejudice any future sale negotiations for the subject land.

The Presiding Member reported:

- (a) On 8th October 2013 Council received a Development Application seeking approval to park 6 loaded trailers on a temporary basis for twelve months at 30 White Avenue, Mount Gambier for Amberich Pty Ltd. Council was further advised verbally that there would be twelve loaded trailers located on the site;
- (b) when considering the history of this site and the nature of the proposed development, on 9th October, 2013 Council forwarded the Development Application and supporting documentation to it's legal advisors seeking assistance in the correct definition/classification of the proposed development;
- (c) Council by letter dated 23rd October, 2013 advised the applicant that the proposed development is best defined as a 'junk yard' and would be processed as a non-complying form of development, which would be required to be publicly notified as a Category 3 development. Category 3 developments involve the formal notification of the adjoining property owners and the general public of the proposed development. The Environment, Resources and Development Court has previously recognised that 'junk yard' continues to be included within Council's Development Plan, despite the removal of the definition of 'junk yard' from the Development Regulations. At this time Council has also sought additional information to assist in the assessment of the Development Application;
- (d) the Applicant by letter dated 22nd November, 2013 has advised that they have lodged a Notice of Appeal with the Environment, Resources and Development Court against Council's decision in respect to the nature of the development and its categorisation;
- (e) the Development Application and supporting documentation has been forwarded to Council's legal representatives to represent Council before Environment, Resources and Development Court in relation to this matter.
