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BACKGROUND

Council at it's meeting held in October, 2013 determined "Council seek authorisation from the Minister for Urban Development and Planning for Interim Authorisation for the Local Heritage and Lakes Zone Development Plan Amendment and to commence public consultation".

DISCUSSION

Council has received advice from the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) outlining that there are some issues that require clarification and/or amendment in regard to the Local Heritage and Lakes Zone Development Plan Amendment (DPA).

Through discussions with David Barone of Jensen Planning and Design, the project consultant, the majority of the issues as raised by DPTI can be easily resolved and accommodated.

It has been raised that Council will require specialist input from a heritage consultant in regards to the following issues raised by DPTI:

An explanation of Heritage Significance of proposed places; and

Strategic Planning and Development Policy Report No. 1/2014 Cont'd...

 An explanation of the Heritage Significance of the proposed new John Street Historic Conservation Area.

It is important to note that this Development Plan Amendment is based upon the Review of the Local Heritage Survey that was undertaken and completed by McDougal and Vines in 2007. McDougal and Vines are recognized heritage consultants and it was always envisaged that their work to review the Heritage Survey would form the basis for any amendment to the Development Plan.

All of the work undertaken by Jensen Planning and Design in the preparation of the Development Plan Amendment was based upon the recommendations as identified by McDougal and Vines in the review of the Local Heritage Survey completed in 2007.

Council has already invested considerable resources into both the review of the Heritage Survey in 2007 and the preparation of the draft Development Plan Amendment. There is no money available within the current Council budget to engage another heritage consultant to provide additional explanation of the heritage significance of proposed places.

It is also necessary to confirm as to which heritage places the DPTI are seeking further explanation on.

CONCLUSION

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure have requested additional explanation on the heritage significance of proposed places and the new John Street Historic Conservation Area.

This explanation should have already been covered within the review of the Local Heritage Survey completed my McDougal and Vines on behalf of Council which was completed in 2007.

This is not an anticipated cost for this project and as such no budget allocation has been made to undertake this work.

RECOMMENDATION

- (b) the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure be requested to confirm exactly which properties that require additional justification for listing;
