HEARING FORMAT

Mayor Martin will ask members of the public to advise if they wish to appear before Council to make a representation in relation to the draft 2019/20 Annual Business Plan and Budget. The process will be as follows:

 A reminder signal will be given prior to the expiry of five minutes;
- Elected Members will be given the opportunity to ask questions of those making representations through the Chair; and
- Following the representation and questions, the representor will resume their seat in the public gallery.

The purpose of the meeting is to allow representations, ask questions and for Elected Members to furnish themselves with the information they require to be able to make a decision at a later date. It is not intended to be the debate, which would be expected to occur at the meeting, prior to a decision being made.
