 - (ii) The landscaping shall include appropriate treatment to the battered slopes of the pump track to enable the on going maintenance of the landscaping.
- 3. The applicant and Owner be advised that the reasons for Council's Condition of Consent are:
 - (a) To ensure orderly and proper development
 - (b) It is not at serious variance with Council's Development Plan
 - (c) To ensure the appearance of the pump track improves and enhances the amenity and visual appearance of the subject locality.
