## Background

A Petition has been received from Perri-Anne Rasmussen on 27 June 2018 in relation to Taxi By-Law No.6.

## Discussion

The Petition reads:

*We, the undersigned, are concerned citizens who urge the councillors and council staff of the City of Mt Gambier to act now; to keep a taxi by-law for the City of Mt Gambier after 31/12/2018 and beyond, to protect and support the 24/7 taxi service that currently operates under councils licensed Taxi By-Law No.6.*

*To put out for public consultation and conduct a Community Impact Assessment in relation to the expiry of the current Taxi By-Law No.6*

The Petition contains some 800 signatures (including names, addresses and comments) primarily from the Mount Gambier and surrounding areas.

The covering letter that accompanied the Petition seeks urgent consideration and action including to put out for public consultation and conduct a Community Impact Assessment in relation to the expiry of the current Taxi By-Law No.6.

A copy of the Petition and covering letter are attached for information.

The subject matter of the petition, the expiry of By-Law No.6 – Taxi Regulation, was considered by Council on 20 February 2018 and in this regard Council resolved:

- (a) *That the repeal of the last remaining provisions of the Local Government Act 1934 having removed the legal basis for Council's Taxi By-Law and Taxi Licensing scheme, that:*
- *Council's Taxi Licensing scheme will cease after 31 December 2018, and*
  - *The Council administration liaise with current licensed Taxi Operators and the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure for the transition of Taxi Operators to an unlicensed regime as operates across the rest of the State of South Australia.*
  - *Council supports the local and wider taxi industry to lobby the state government for improved state wide regulation and oversight of regional taxi services. Such support might occur as part of the transition up to and beyond 1 January 2019 if sought and supported by the local taxi industry.*

The City of Mount Gambier has made no deliberative decision to cease taxi regulation by Council and has no power to re-instate or replace the expiring By-Law. The repeal of legislative provisions removing the legal power of Council to make By-Laws relating to the operation of taxis within its area was an action of the State Government bringing Mount Gambier in line with the rest of the state.

Public consultation or a community impact assessment conducted by Council could mislead and raise community expectation that Council has the power to alter a decision in regard to this matter.



If public consultation and/or a community impact assessment (or similar) on the repeal of by-law making powers relating to taxi regulation are considered as being warranted then this is a matter that would be appropriately addressed to the State Government as the relevant law-maker.

### **Conclusion**

The Petition is now presented formally for Council to receive.
