Background

Section 184(1) of the Local Government Act, 1999 provides a power for Council to sell land if an amount payable by way of rates in respect of land has been arrears for three (3) years or more.

Discussion

A property situated at 3 Lexington Crescent, Mount Gambier described as Lot 291 DP43609 CT5321/891 has an outstanding balance (rates, fines and interest and legal fees) of \$4,316.74 to 30th August 2017.

The rates have now become outstanding for a period exceeding three (3) years and Council should exercise its right pursuant to Chapter 10, part 1, Division 9 of the Local Government Act, 1999 to seek to sell the land for non-payment of Council rates, fines etc;

In terms of the disbursement of any funds as a result of the sale of the property, Section 184 (11) of the Local Government Action 1999 provides:

- Any money received by the council in respect of the sale of land under this section will be "(11) applied as follows:
 - (a) firstly - in paying the costs of the sale and any other costs incurred in proceeding under this section;
 - (b) secondly - in discharging any liabilities to the council in respect of the land;
 - thirdly in discharging any liability to the Crown for rates, charges or taxes, or any (C) prescribed liability to the Crown in respect of the land;
 - (d) fourthly - in discharging any liabilities secured by registered mortgages, encumbrances or charges;
 - fifthly in discharging any other mortgages, encumbrances and charges of which the (e) council has notice;
 - sixthly in payment to the owner of the land." (f)

Conclusion

Noting the outstanding rates, fines, etc owed to Council in relation to the property situated at 3 Lexington Crescent, Mount Gambier now exceed the three (3) years or more provided for under Section 184(1) of the Local Government Act, it is recommended that Council approve proceeding to sale of the property.
