REPORT RECOMMENDATION

- 1. That Regional Sport and Recreation Centre Committee Report No. AR19/54110 titled 'Update on Expressions of Interest and Select Tender processes for the construction of the Community and Recreation Hub' as presented on 12 November 2019 be noted.
- 2. That Council endorse the approach to proceed through a select tender process with all six companies that participated in the Expressions of Interest process for the Community and Recreation Hub project.
- 3. That Council note that following the select tender process, a report will be brought back before Council enabling a decision to be made to proceed with a preferred supplied.

BACKGROUND

To advise Council that an Expressions of Interest process was undertaken as the first part of a procurement process to secure a head contractor for the Community and Recreation Hub project.

This process was open to any company via the procurement platform Tenders SA, as required by granting funding requirements. It commenced on 22nd August 2019 and closed on 20th September 2019.

The intent of this process was to ensure that the companies expressing an interest in undertaking the project had the capacity and capability to undertake a project of this scope and scale. This included assessments of their experience in similar projects and their financial sustainability, together with an understanding of their intention to capture local content in the project. All submissions were deemed to comply with the Council's procurement rules and standards, despite varying in quality and quantity.

The cost of providing the Community and Recreation Hub was not sought or provided through this exercise.

Six expressions of interest were received and subsequently considered by a panel of officers and external experts. Having reviewed independently all submissions, the review group then met collectively and discussed its findings. All six were considered to have the potential to deliver a successful project. There was consensus that shortlisting further from the six submissions would not improve competitiveness or outcomes for the Council and community.

It is therefore recommended that the next stage of the procurement process includes all six companies who have lodged an expression of interest. The six companies are:

- BADGE Constructions (SA) Pty Ltd
- BMD Constructions
- Hutchinson Builders
- Kennett Pty Ltd
- Mossop Constructions and Interiors
- Sarah Constructions Pty Ltd

As a result of the process undertaken, feedback will be provided to the six companies to enable them to improve upon any deficiencies in their work prior to their final submission. This will give the Council a greater degree of certainty and quality when considering the final submissions as a result of the select tender process. This next process will focus on the time, quality and cost elements, having ascertained the credentials of the companies through the expressions of interest process.

Should a significantly greater number of expressions of interest have been submitted, it would have been the approach of the Council Administration to shortlist to reduce the number to probably five. The impact of not doing this will be to create a small amount of extra work in reviewing the extra submission. The disbenefit of this is outweighed by the expected benefits to the Council and community from having a larger pool to select from.

NEXT STEPS

Given the update provided in the confidential briefing on 22nd October 2019 and the delay caused by the lack of completed structural engineering drawings, the next steps in the process are intended to be:

 Written advice to the six companies advising that they have been selected to proceed to the next stage in the process and advising them that the information to complete the select tender will be released in a single stage on Tuesday, 3rd December 2019 and will include a

bill of quantities and a draft contract and when the tender period will close (1200hrs on Friday, 24th January 2020).

- Communication with the Community Reference Group and an embargoed meeting with *The Border Watch* as to the current design (Monday, 2nd December 2019)
- Release of tender information to the six companies (Tuesday, 3rd December 2019);
- Close of tender period at 1200hrs (Friday, 24th January 2020);
- Assessment of the tender submissions;
- Clarification of submissions or elements within them (if required);
- Preparation of Council reports and Elected Member briefing;
- Decision by Council;
- Further negotiations with preferred two (or possibly three) tenderers; and
- Award of contract.


CONCLUSION

Proceeding to the next stage of the procurement process with all six companies who have lodged an expression of interest. This provides a small element of contingency should a company decide not to proceed through the final elements of the process.

The timeframe to complete this work is very stretching for the Council and will be stretching for the tenderers, hence the importance of giving them information as early as possible and making them aware of the split in the release of information and what is being done to help them.
