 - (vi)The development shall be consistent with the relevant provisions identified within the current Environment Protection (Commercial and Industrial Nosie) Policy 2023 as identified by the Environment Protection Authority, specifically in the provision of sounds and/or others emitted from the subject church.

 - (i) The development shall be carried out in accordance with the Plan/s as approved by Council and with the Conditions of Approval.
 - (ii) The hours of operation of the business and use of the property shall not create a nuisance and/or disturbance for any person/s and/or property in the immediate area.
 - (iii) The development shall be consistent with the relevant provisions identified within the current Environment Protection (Commercial and Industrial Noise) Policy 2023 as identified by the Environment Protection Authority, specifically in the provision of music and/or other noises emitted from the subject gymnasium.
 - (iv) The operation of the Indoor Recreation Centre (Gymnasium) shall occur within the operating criteria as detailed within the Acoustic Report as provided to Council (Reference 8 Ramsay Avenue, Mount Gambier, Noise Assessment, Rp 001 20200803 dated 3 September as prepared by Marshall Day Acoustics) so as to not create a nuisance and/or disturbance for any person/s and/or property in the subject locality.
