Background

On the 5th June 2018 the Mount Gambier Regional Sport and Recreation Centre Committee resolved the following:

7.2 Motion Without Notice

That Council establish a Community Reference Group represented by a cross section of stakeholders and community members to contribute to the project by:

- Participating in its design so that the needs of future users are considered
- Provide a local perspective on the impact of the facility in terms of use and access

The Community Reference Group will seek a minimum composition of the following representatives, with the ability to modify the composition as determined by the Committee.

1 x primary school

1 x secondary school

1 x local swim school provider

1 x allied health care provider

1 x retirement/residential care facility

1 x childcare provider

1 x community youth group

4 x sport/ recreation clubs

2 x other community groups

Terms of Reference will be established and endorsed by the Committee and Council.

At the Council meeting held 19th June 2018 this Motion was passed with a noted amendment to add Basketball, Netball, Swimming and Tennis as specific representative groups to the composition of the Community Reference Group.

In accordance with the Council resolution, all Community Reference Group Application documents were updated to reflect the change in composition.

Discussion

Applications for the Community Reference Group opened Friday 22nd June 2018. Members of the original Community Group were sent an email advising the application process was open on the evening of Thursday 21st June 2018 and encouraging them to both lodge an application and to invite others from their regional networks and the community to apply

A media release on the City of Mount Gambier website went live on the morning of Friday 22nd June 2018, and social media channels also promoted the Community Reference Group via Twitter and Facebook.

Members of the community were encouraged to lodge an online application via the City of Mount Gambier 'Have Your Say' page, and were also able to post in or personally lodge their applications at Civic Centre.

Applications closed 5.00pm Thursday 5th July 2018. A total of 17 applications were received with 10 applicants lodged under one category only, with the other seven applying under multiple categories of the Community Reference Group composition.

12 of the 17 applicants were male, and five female. The majority of applicants (12) were aged between the ages of 36 and 55, with one applicant being under 18 years of age, three being aged between 15 and 18 years of age, and one aged 56 and 69 years of age.

Once the application lodgement period closed, members of the Regional Sport and Recreation Committee were provided with a copy of each application on 6th July for evaluation. The Committee were also provided with an assessment matrix to consider the merits of each application.

The Mount Gambier Regional Sport and Recreation Centre Committee met at a designated informal gathering on 10th July to discuss the Community Reference Group membership applications.

At this meeting, the Committee discussed the applications and proposed that as all applicants were suitable and as there were 17 applications for 17 positions, all applicants would be invited to form the Mount Gambier Regional Sport and Recreation Centre Community Reference Group. The sectors of the community the applicants represent are as follows (in no particular order):
