### 1. FLAG REQUEST – Ref. AF11/2285

There are specific protocols for the flying of the Australian National and other flags. Council does not ordinarily fly any flags in the Cave Garden and Civic Precinct on weekends.

Should Council support the request, it is proposed that the Australian National Flag and the Aboriginal Flag be raised and lowered to half mast, using the 2 poles fronting Watson Terrace, that ordinarily are used to fly the Aboriginal Flag and Torres Strait Islander Flag on weekdays.
