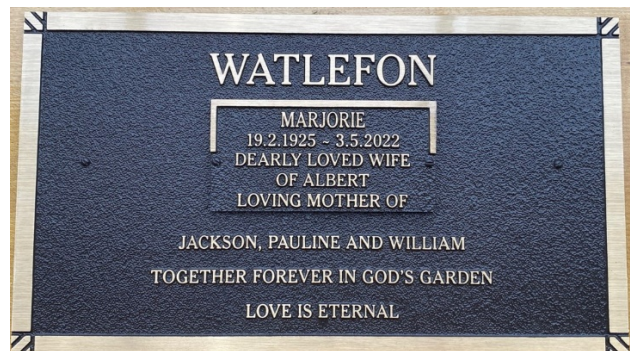

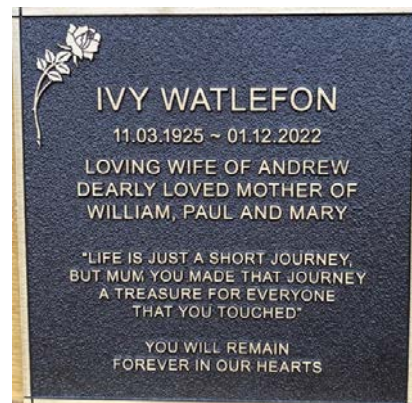

## EXTRACT FROM CEMETERY PROCEDURE - CARINYA GARDENS CEMETERY BURIALS

### **1. OBLIGATIONS OF INTERMENT RIGHT HOLDERS**

A memorial plaque may be placed at the interment site. Plaques must be ordered at the Carinya Gardens Cemetery office. Application to install a plaque sourced from a different supplier must be made in writing and will be assessed on a case by case basis.

The care and maintenance of any item of memorialisation is the responsibility of the Interment Right Holder.

The Council will not accept any responsibility for the theft or damage to any item of memorialisation.

#### Flowers and Ornaments:

- Fresh or artificial flowers are welcome memorial tributed in all areas of Carinya Gardens Cemetery.
- Items of glass, porcelain or ceramic such as vases, receptacles, ornaments, wind chimes, solar lights and any items that are broken, in poor condition or pose a hazard are not permitted.
- Memorial tributes, including fresh and artificial flowers, which have deteriorated will be removed at the discretion of Council.
- Non floral items removed by Council staff will be stored for a period of four weeks, after which the items will be disposed of.
- Floral tributes, ornaments, windchimes etc are not permitted to be attached to trees, shrubs or memorial surrounds at any memorial site.
- The picking of flowers and plants is prohibited.
- The unauthorised planting of flora is prohibited within the cemetery and will be removed upon detection.
- A maximum of two plastic cemetery courtesy vases are permitted on each burial allotment at any given time.
- Brass vases are available to purchase from the cemetery office.
- Tributes to be placed on concrete area of allotment only. Tributes must not be placed on grassed areas and will be removed and disposed of when lawns are cut.
- A person must not place any item likely to cause a risk to health or safety on a memorial or place of interment.
- A person placing an item on a memorial or place of interment must ensure that the item does not extend beyond the boundaries of the memorial or place of interment.
