





LIMESTONE COAST SOUTHERN REGIONAL ASSESSMENT PANEL CALL FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST - INDEPENDENT MEMBERS TWO VACANCIES

Together the District Council of Grant, the Wattle Range Council, the District Council of Robe and the City of Mount Gambier have agreed to form the Limestone Coast Southern Regional Assessment Panel commencing on 1 July 2022.

Expressions of interest are now being sought from members of the public who would like to be considered for appointment as an independent member of the Regional Assessment Panel (LCSRAP). The role of the LCSRAP is to make decisions on a wide range of development applications within the respective council areas.

The LCSRAP is to be comprised of five members who have an interest in urban and regional planning, with appropriate qualifications and experience relevant to the LCSRAP. As a guide, it is anticipated that independent members could come from the field of architecture, landscape architecture, civil engineering, planning, law, building, environmental planning or similar fields. It is a requirement that all members of the LCSRAP obtain accreditation from Plan SA as Planning Level 2 to be able to be a member of the panel.

Independent members will be compensated for their time and expertise by an appropriate level of remuneration. The term of the LCSRAP is for a two year period concluding on Monday 1 July 2024.
