The Les Hill Historical Centre houses a collection of local history materials relevant to Mount Gambier.

The Les Hill Historical Centre resources are available for use by the general public, but no items of the collection may be borrowed from the Public Library.

The collection will consist of:

- 1. Published monographs relating to Mount Gambier and the South East;
- 2. Unpublished monographs relating to Mount Gambier and the South East;
- 3. Newspapers relevant to Mount Gambier and the South East;
- 4. Archival material relating to Mount Gambier organisations and businesses;
- 5. Personal documents and records of Mount Gambier and district residents;
- 6. Beguests accepted by the City of Mount Gambier.

The collection policy specifically excludes:

- 1. Photographs (excluding photographs which may be part of any of the above items);
- 2. Artefacts;
- 3. Material not relevant to Mount Gambier i.e. old and rare books outside the scope of the collection.

NOTE: Council may retain any photographs and these photographs will be indexed and archived in the Council's existing photographic register held within the administration section of Council.

Any donations not specifically relevant to Mount Gambier, but relevant to other library collections in the South East should be directed to those libraries.

Any donations to the Les Hill Historical Centre, are only accepted under the terms of the Conditions of Donation form.

The Public Library will not accept loans of material.

All donations will be considered as outright gifts and will be formally acknowledged by letter. Donors will be required to sign a legal agreement which addresses the issues of copyright access and reproduction of the material (refer to the Conditions of Donation form).
